MIAMI, FL — Miami businesswoman and philanthropist Adrienne Arsht has listed her stunning waterfront estate for \$150 million.

Arsht bought the home in 1996 for \$4 million, according to Redfin.

The four-acre parcel sits directly on Biscayne Bay and is comprised of two homes, each with sweeping views of Key Biscayne and Downtown Miami, according to Redfin.

If sold for the asking price, the sale would <u>set a Florida record</u> for the sale of a singlefamily home at \$150 million, according to the Real Deal. The current record is December's <u>\$75 million sale of a 1.8-acre estate</u> on Star Island in Miami Beach, reports said.

The daughter of Delaware's first female judge, Arsht was an attorney in the Washington, D.C. area, where she became known for hosting salons at her home, according to Philanthropy magazine. She's also hosted numerous world leaders, ambassadors and U.S. presidents at her South Florida estate.

She moved to Miami in the mid-1990s to run Total Bank, according to reports. Under Arsht's leadership, <u>the bank expanded significantly</u>, growing from four to 14 locations, and its assets quadrupled to \$1.4 billion.

She's also a well-known philanthropist in South Florida and beyond. In 2008, she donated \$30 million for Miami's Performing Arts Center, now called the Adrienne Arsht Center for the Performing Arts, according to the venue's website.

Since then, Arsht has made <u>other high-profile donations</u>, including \$10 million to the Lincoln Center, which dedicated the Adrienne Arsht State in Alice Tully Hall to her, and \$5 million to the Metropolitan Museum in New York City to fund its first-ever paid internship program.

She also founded the Adrienne Arsht Latin American Center at the Atlantic Council in 2013 and spearheaded what is now called the Adrienne Arsht-Rockefeller Foundation Resilience Center in 2016. The philanthropist is also a trustee of the John F. Kennedy Center for the Performing Arts, where she established the Adrienne Arsht Theater Fund.
